- PhD Ecosystem : Sustainable Development

## **Travel information**

### How to get to Rouen

# From Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG)

- You can take the train RER B (towards Gare de Massy and until Châtelet): Châtelet: metro line 14 (towards Saint-Lazare) – Gare Saint-Lazare (take the train to Rouen).
- You can also take the bus Roissybus which leaves from the airport and will drop you off at the Opera station in 60 minutes. From this station you have to walk about 5 minutes to Gare Saint-Lazare, where you can take the train to Rouen (Rouen Rive Droite).

# From ORLY Airport

- Take the **metro line 14** (towards Gare Saint-Lazare) at Gare Saint- Lazare take the train towards Rouen Rive Droite.
- You can take the ORLYVAL shuttle (towards Antony) at Antony station take the RER B (towards Paris) to Châtelet-les-Halles. From there you can take the metro line 14 (Towards Mairie de Saint-Ouen) - at Gare Saint-Lazare station take the train towards Rouen Rive Droite.

### From Paris-Beauvais Airport

You can take the **shuttle** to Paris Gare du Nord. The trip to Paris Gare du Nord lasts 1h15.
 You can buy the ticket online or at the airport. Then, you can take the train RER E line to Gare Saint-Lazare station. There, take the train towards Rouen Rive Droite.
